
It is okay to talk about Suicide

Thoughts of giving up and suicide can be frightening. Take **Them Seriously!**




KNOW THE RISKS

- Construction has the Highest Number of Male Suicide Deaths.
- The CDC reports that 20% of all men who die by suicide were in construction/extraction.
- The construction industry has the secondhighest suicide rate of any industry in the US. In 2018, the rate of suicides in

construction was **5** X greater than the rate for all fatal work-related injuries

Check-In with your health care provider to discuss what you are thinking and how you are feeling.
