Understanding the Risks

The Construction Industry has:

- The highest number of male suicide deaths
- The second-highest suicide rate of any industry in the US.
- Five times more suicides than fatal work-related injuries.

In 2022, the share of employed Veterans working in the construction industry was 6.5%.
